Who Can Receive Community Care Options Services?

Community Care Options serves Calhoun County residents who are 60 years of age or older and need some help with the responsibilities of keeping their home clean and safe.

Homemaking, meal preparation, limited errands, and other supports are available for seniors with household incomes at or below 200% of poverty.

Care assessment, care planning, home safety assessments and referral to community services and problem solving are offered regardless of income.
